

In 2023, our church was blessed to have 153 new people that have joined the church or are in process of joining our church. Through October of this year, we have had an additional 103 new people. God is leading people to us, and we love everyone that is coming. As our church is growing, our ministries are growing. We are making steps to add new employees in needed areas to both serve and minister to those already attending our church and to accommodate the growth we anticipate to continue in the upcoming year.

We look to hire our new Pastor of Worship in 2025. We are hiring ministry residents to help us expand our ministry in both Children's Ministry, Student Ministry, and College & Young Adult Ministry, and we will be employing seasonal interns in a number of ministries. We are adding some specialized administrative staff to help with member assimilation, volunteer retention, and a new data system that we will be transitioning to in 2025. In addition to new positions, other items included in Staff Expenses are increases in benefits, increases in insurance costs, and raises & cost of living adjustments.

As a student ministry resident for almost nine months, I have been privileged to learn so about ministry from Rob, other pastors, other student ministry leaders, and the students. There have been so many events that I have seen grow both students and me in this time, but the one that stands out to me the most was Student Life Camp at Shocco Springs in May. I got to see the "light bulb" go on for several students whether it was God calling them to salvation or calling them to ministry. This is just a small fraction of the great things I have seen God accomplish in this student ministry which is only part of this church.


